# CPRIT

- ❖ Cost of Cancer in Texas Increases
- ❖ CPRIT ROI = \$2 Billion in Output
  - Every CPRIT \$1 = \$4.78 in Output
  - Every CPRIT \$1 = \$1.99 in Revenue
- ☑ More than 14,000 Jobs Created
- ☑ Interim Hearing – November 18

## **34 CPRIT Scholars in Cancer Research**

- ❖ \$500 Million Attracted Over 15 Years
- ❖ 1 Scholar responsible for 20 scientists relocating to Texas within 3 months

## **9 Company Investments = \$160 Million ROI**

- ❖ \$57M in Follow-On Investment
- ❖ 1 Company Acquisition for \$80 Million
- ❖ 1 Company Received FDA Approval for Device

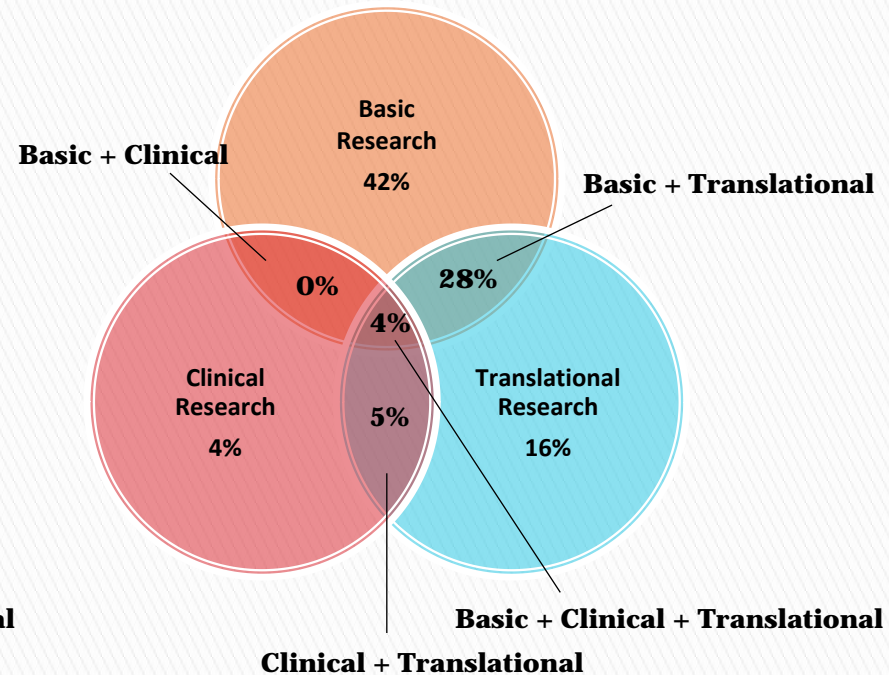

**2010 – 2011 Prevention Progress**

~50,000 Texans Screened

~27,000 Texans Never Screened Before

A 53 year old female, never had a mammogram, diagnosed with breast cancer:

*“I was lucky my cancer was detected early – without this program .... it may have been too late. I have told my friends, family and neighbors about this program .... I sincerely hope this program continues, it may have saved my life”*
